These programs and clinics provide juniors ages 4-17 an opportunity to learn about golf from our staff of PGA/LPGA instructors. At the introductory level students will learn such fundamentals as grip, stance, posture, safety and etiquette. Advancement will include building on these fundamental skills as they learn to putt, chip, pitch and drive. At the advanced level the students are given an opportunity to compete with their peers on the golf course in a tournament setting.

> *SESSIONS START AT THE BEGINNING OF THE MONTH Equipment and balls are provided and included in all fees. (1 student=20 min. 2 students=40 min. and 3 + = 60 min.) Progression is as follows:

Start Smart Little Linkers

LEVEL 1: Introduction to the Game of Golf
